

Honor Patrol Qualifications

In order to promote the use of the patrol method in and out of camp, Camp Wakpominee has established a set of requirements to give scouts practice functioning at the patrol level. As a prerequisite for receiving the Troop Excellence Award, a majority of the troop's patrols must qualify for Honor Patrol standing.

Each troop's SPL should use this form to track individual patrol progress. Once each requirement has been met, he and the Scoutmaster should sign below. This form should be turned in at the office upon completion.

NOTE: The camp reserves the right to disqualify any patrol for unscout-like behavior.

- _____ Leadership: Each patrol functions with an appointed Patrol Leader and Assistant Patrol Leader.
- _____ Spirit: Patrol members demonstrate Scout Spirit in and out of their campsite, In part, this will be measured by proper uniform, personal cleanliness, campsite appearance, general conduct at camp wide activities and in the dining hall, good sportsmanship and punctuality.
- _____ Cooperation: Patrol members share daily responsibility, including dishwashing, sweeping the latrine, etc.
- _____ Project: Each patrol performs a campsite improvement project approved by the camp's program Director or Commissioners.
- _____ Participation: Each patrol performs at least one skit or song, which involves all of its members at an in-site troop/inter-troop campfire.
